Second hand uniform sale

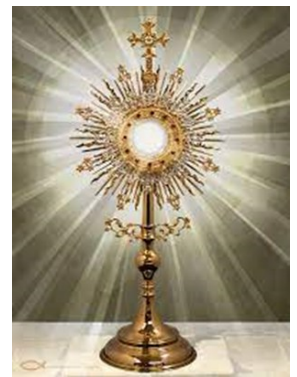
The next second hand uniform sale will take place in the playground at school pick up time on 18th June for Year 1 .

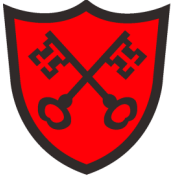
