You will also receive a ballot document with the names of the candidates (in alphabetical order).

You may vote for only **one** candidate. Each parent can submit one ballot paper, regardless of the number of pupils you have attending the school. As indicated on the ballot paper, you should vote by marking an 'X' alongside the name of the parent you support.

Once you have marked the ballot paper, save the document, **ensuring you do not include any personally identifying details**. This should be sent as an attachment to the dedicated email address for this election, GovernorElection@stalbans.cambs.sch.uk, by **3.15 p.m. on Friday 25 November**.

Please use the **email address you have registered for school contact** to return your ballot. Addresses will be checked against the school records to confirm eligibility, and ballots then saved separately to preserve anonymity.

If it is not possible for you to vote electronically, please contact the school office in order to make arrangements to return your vote using a printed ballot.

The election will be decided by a simple majority of votes cast. In the event of a tie, lots will be drawn.

When the election has been completed, I will let you know the outcome. If, in the meantime, you have any queries, please let me know.
