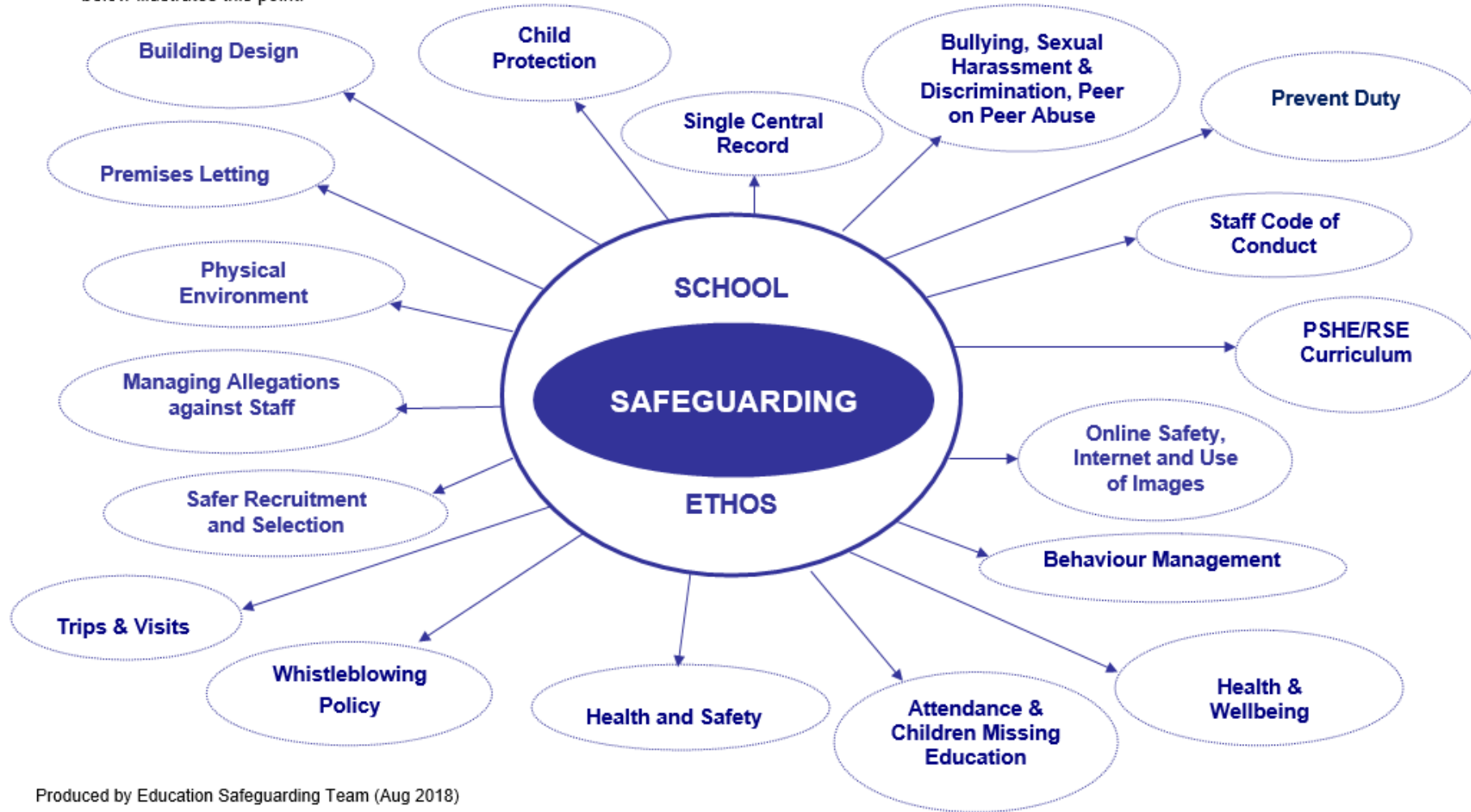


Safeguarding Children in Education
